**ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution, namely **Sanjay Gandhi College of Education, 62/2A, 2B, Chola Nagar, Hebbal, Bangalore-560032** was granted recognition for conducting **(B.Ed.)** course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide SRC, NCTE's vide order no. F.KAR/B.Ed./065/SRO/NCTE/2000-2001 dated 11.07.2000 from the academic session 2000-2001.

AND WHEREAS, the Tamilnadu Teachers Education University had forwarded a copy of show cause notice issued to the institution for not functioning in accordance with the conditions stipulated by the NCTE, SRC, Bangalore and Tamilnadu Teachers Education University as could be apprehended from the report of Inspection commission which caused a surprise visit to the colleges.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 27.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 30.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16 subject to fulfilment of conditions mentioned therein.**

AND WHEREAS, subsequently the SRC issued a Corrigendum vide order dated 30.06.2015 permitting the institution to have one basis unit of 50 students subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely:

The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institution shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 369<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 13.03.2019. The institution vide letter dated 21.03.2019 submitted its reply along with documents.

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AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 378<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> - 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2019 considered the matter and decided as a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution vide dated 30.07.2019. The institution vide letter dated 16.08.2019 & 25.02.2019 submitted its reply to the Final Show Cause Notice along with documents.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 387<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> - 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue a Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution. Accordingly, a withdrawal order was issued to the institution vide dt.09.09.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the institution preferred an appeal u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 and the Appellate Authority vide order No. F.No.89-230/E-167583/2020 Appeal/30<sup>th</sup> Mtg.-2020/03<sup>rd</sup> December, 2020/95804 dt.21.12.2020 remanded back the matter to SRC. The institution has submitted its reply against the remand back along with documents vide dated 30.12.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 393<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> January, 2021 considered and decided as the following grounds:

**"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -**

*On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution **Sanjay Gandhi College of Education, Chola Nagar, Hebbal, Bangalore-560032** for B.Ed programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students."*

NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **Sanjay Gandhi College of Education, 62/2A, 2B, Chola Nagar, Hebbal, Bangalore-560032** for continuation of recognition for B.Ed programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.

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IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

1. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc as applicable.

2. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

3. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
  - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
  - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
  - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
  - e. Fee charged from students;
  - f. Available infrastructural facilities;
  - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
  - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
  - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
  - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
  - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
4. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
  5. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
  6. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
