

- The chairperson presented a brief overview of EduSkill Elevate Programme (ESEP) signifying its objectives, relevance and contributory benefits in the preparation of future ready teachers . She emphasized that the age-old B.Ed., curriculum in itself may not be able to fulfill the needs of the stakeholders due to changed societal demands and expectation. There is a dire need to extend the curriculum from skill enrichment point of view and the EduSkill Elevate Programme (ESEP) spread across the two years B.Ed. course will be able to fill that need based gap between the age-old curriculum and contemporary academic needs.
  - The cell members acknowledged the fact and appreciated the initiative vision towards quality escalation of the course . The committee also comprehensively chalked out the tentative programme ,its objectives , list of the to be focussed on skills : Pedagogical skills , content enrichment, 21<sup>st</sup> century skills, ICT skills etc.
  - It was decided that the approved programme and activities under EduSkill Elevate Programme (ESEP) will be overseen bey an in-charge teacher educator under the guidance of the principal of the SGCE. However, it was also decided to consult the course /programme specific resource persons/ agencies to carry out the listed programmes meaningfully .In charge teacher educators were asked to prepare an action plan for the implementation of each activity allotted to them and get the approval of the same by the head of the institution.
  - Roles and responsibilities of the all the events/ activities were discussed and allotted as per the area of interest and expertise. The committed resolved to conduct the ESEP as pilot level and asked the in charge teachers to look forward for the staff and students feedback for its effects and performance.



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
